Baritone, Opera Singer

Rajiv Cerezo Chugani, is an international baritone born in 1992 in Madrid and settled in Germany. He studied with international career teachers such as; Milagros Poblador, Santiago Calderon, Christopher Robertson.... He received Masterclasses from the renowned soprano Lisette Oropesa. Currently his teacher is Vicenzo Spatola.

After finishing his studies at the Escuela Superior de Canto de Madrid, he was selected for the CRESENDÔ Program of the Teatro Real, a program for young artists.

He has sung in several Spanish and European theatres such as the Teatro Real (Madrid), Teatro Calderón (Madrid), Teatro Olympia (Valencia), Teatro del Canal (Madrid), Teatro Auditorio (San Lorenzo de El Escorial), Teatro Auditorio José Luis Perales (Cuenca), Köln Philharmonie (Cologne), Théâtre de Paris (Paris), Tropiques Atrium Scène Nationale (Martinique), Auditorio Nacional (Madrid), Auditorio Alfredo Kraus (Las Palmas de Gran Canaria), Palacio de Congresos (Zaragoza), Teatro Tívoli (Barcelona), Auditorio de Palma (Palma de Mallorca).

He has worked under the guidance of musical directors such as Karel Marek Chichon, Manuel Coves, Sir Neville Marriner, Miguel Roa, among others, and has worked with artists of the stature of Elina Garançã.

He premiered the zarzuela 'Luisa Fernanda' with the singer Elina Garançã at the Teatro Real. In 2024 he debuted the roles of Dancairo and Morales in the opera Carmen in a tour of Spain with the company LG Artist Management. At the end of that year he performed his first Lied concert, singing Mahler's cycle 'Lieder eines fahrenden gesellen' with the Orquesta Sinfónica del Atlántico. In 2025 he debuted in the National Auditorium of Mexico. Debuted also the Role of Renato from "Un ballo in maschera" by Verdi in Belgium in the summer festival of Alden Biesen. His has been accepted also in the Sabadell's Opera academy to perform "Le nozze di Figaro" by Mozart performing the role of The conte Almaviva. In August he debuted the role of Figaro "Il Barbieri di Siviglia" In Sicilia in the Medieval Castle of Caccamo.
